BS/MAcc Concurrent Program Application Requirements

- Currently pursuing a bachelor's degree
- Concurrent students must have completed at least two 3000 level accounting classes
- 3.0 or higher accounting GPA
- 3.0 or higher GPA on your last 60 semesters (or 90 quarter) credits
- Official GMAT scores (*not required*): The Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) scores may be provided for consideration for merit-based tuition waivers such as the Excellence waiver

***Admission into the concurrent program will be on a competitive basis and meeting the conditions of eligibility to apply is no guarantee of admission.**
