## College of Eastern Utah

Pass an approved computer literacy test. Successful completion is posted at the beginning of the transcript. If a student takes one of the following courses, the test will be administered as part of the course. Credit hours will go towards elective hours.

## Snow College

## Southern Utah University

New requirement beginning Fall 2000. Students may pass a test for the Business Department and a statement will be posted on the transcript. Most students will satisfy requirement by completing:

## Utah State University

Successful completion of Computer and Information Literacy examination. Students must pass all six modules. A notation is placed at the beginning of the transcript. Several courses are offered to prepare for the exam. However, no specific course satisfies the requirement.

## Utah Valley State College

Not an institutional requirement. Currently required only for the School of Business. Business students must pass a computer proficiency exam (which will be noted on the student's transcript) or take the following course:

Successful completion of Computer and Information Literacy (four) examinations completed by taking one of the following groups of approved courses. Posted on transcript as part of AS or AA degree. Courses are coded individually.
