- **Option areas are offered based on resource availability.**
- **Admission to the College of Business does not ensure access to the courses required for graduation as prerequisites are enforced on all COB courses.** You can find prerequisites listed in the USU catalog or at www.usu.edu/cobceo.
- **The College of Business Stop-Out policy will be followed.** A break in attendance of the Business program in excess of one year will be subject to the college and departmental requirements in effect at the time of return.
- **All students must meet USU and COB residency requirements found in the USU catalog.**
- **The P/D+, D, F option is not available for any courses required for the Business major.**
- **To be eligible for graduation, students must satisfy all University, college, and departmental major requirements.**

- **Fully accredited Business degrees upon completion of requirements.**
- **Quality education in remote locations.**

- **COB Core courses will be offered on an annual cycle.**
