## A Business (MIS Option) Degree in 3 Years

The Bachelor of Science Degree (BS) in Business is designed to prepare graduates with the foundation skills for administrative positions in business, government, and other institutions. The degree provides a good mix of breadth and depth in the fundamental areas of business. Options in Management, Accounting, and Management Information Systems are available to provide depth in each of these areas. Courses are offered weeknights each semester via interactive broadcast delivery to enable nontraditional students who work full or part time to progress toward completion of their degree. Many courses are also available online or through Independent Study. Below you will find a sample degree plan for the MIS option. It is based on a student who begins the program in an odd-year Fall semester and attends eight successive semesters.
