Huntsman School of Business. Students may complete up to 15 USU Huntsman School of Business required credits numbered 2000 and above including transfer credits prior to formal admittance to the Huntsman School. Students transferring more than 15 acceptable credits must receive Huntsman School admittance prior to completing further Huntsman School required courses. Huntsman School applications are processed every semester. Applications must be received by December 1 for Spring, April 1 for Summer, and July 1 for Fall. In order to register for 3000-, 4000- and 5000-level courses in the Huntsman School, a 2.67 overall GPA is required. A 2.50 GPA in core and major courses is required for graduation. For semester availability and prerequisites, see the USU general catalog or check online at www.huntsman.usu.edu/ceo/. All Utah State University graduation requirements must be met. Check USU catalog for more information regarding requirements. It is strongly recommended that graduation applications be completed two semesters prior to graduation.
