Huntsman School of Business.</li> <li>• Students may complete up to 15 USU Huntsman School of Business required credits numbered 2000 and above including transfer credits prior to formal admittance to the Huntsman School.</li> <li>• Students transferring more than 15 acceptable credits must receive Huntsman School admittance prior to completing further Huntsman School required courses.</li> <li>• Huntsman School applications are processed every semester. Applications must be received by December 1 for Spring, April 1 for Summer, and July 1 for Fall.</li> <li>• In order to register for 3000-, 4000- and 5000-level courses in the Huntsman School, a 2.67 overall GPA is required.</li> <li>• A 2.50 GPA in core and major courses is required for graduation.</li> <li>• For semester availability and prerequisites, see the USU general catalog or check online at <a href="http://www.huntsman.usu.edu">www.huntsman.usu.edu</a>.</li> <li>• All Utah State University graduation requirements must be met.
