The Career Action Plan (CAP) is a personal, step by step method to discover your career objectives. <u>Meet with a Career Coach</u> in the FJ Management Center for Student Success to review/revise your results.

STEP 1: SELF DISCOVERY

Go to the following websites and identify job titles that match your interests, values, skills, and strengths. Select and write down careers of interest for each of the three resources.

a.	Complete the FOCUS 2 Career Assessment. (Click on the "Focus2 Assessment" link under the header "Start Here and Complete Focus2.") You will be prompted to create an account. List careers specified in your FOCUS 2 report that you would like to learn more about.
b.	To find what you can do with your major, click here and then go to "What Can I Do With My Major" (under "Favorite Links.") In the new window, hover over "View All Majors" and click on "Business." (International Business may be found under Global Studies in this resource.) List the careers and job roles that interest you the most.
c.	O*NET OnLine https://www.onetonline.org Insert job titles identified in a-b above into the "Occupational Search" field.

STEP 3: GAP ANALYSIS

Research several job descriptions to determine qualifications. Identify gaps in your skills, knowledge or experience which must be addressed in order for you to qualify for the desired position(s). Use sites such as <u>Handshake</u>, <u>LinkedIn</u> or Indeed to find positions of interest.
